Care About Childcare at Children's Service Society has good news to share- Kids in Care is BACK!

The Kids in Care program (KIC) is for parents who have **recently lost their job** and are seeking employment. The KIC program ensures children have access to regulated child care at no cost to the family. Parents may be approved for up to **150 hours of child care per family.** Care About Child Care at Children's Service Society (CAC-CSS) reimburses the providers directly for KIC care provided.

CAC-CSS is looking for providers that are willing to help parents by providing "drop in" care for their children while parents engage in job searching activities.

Rates for providing KIC "drop in" care have increased to \$5.50 per hour for children ages 2 and under and \$5.00 per hour for children 3 and older.

Dear Child Care Providers,

We are pleased to announce the arrival of the Care About Childcare grant.

There are a few exciting changes to the 2015-16 Care About Childcare grant:

-The grant amounts have increased.

-Programs submitting an "Early Bird" application will receive an additional 10% on their grant amount. The early bird deadline is November 30, 2015.

-If 20% or more of your enrollment is from children whose child care fees are subsidized with state Child Care Assistance funds, your program will receive an additional 10% on the grant amount.

- Please remember, the quality criteria you earned prior to May 2015 need to be renewed before March 31st, 2016 in order to remain displayed on your CAC profile page. The renewal process can be done online and your <u>Care About Childcare agencies</u> are available to help.

- Please take advantage of the CAC grants to help offset the time and effort it takes to achieve quality criteria.

The final deadline for submitting grant applications is March 31st 2016.

Grant funding is limited and awarded on a first come, first served basis.

Child Care Licensing Program Training Opportunities

For Child Care Centers, Licensed Family & Residential Certificates

Thank you for your interest in Licensing Rules Training. These classes are to help you better understand the Child Care Licensing rules and their enforcement.

Pre-registration is required. To register for the class of your choice (see schedule below):

If no one is registered within 48 hours, the class will be cancelled.

- Classes are held at venues independent of the Child Care Licensing Program. If you have any questions about the class, please do not contact the venue.
- Classes are taught according to Care About Child Care specifications. In order to receive Career Ladder credit, you must be there for the entire class. If you do not attend the entire class, you will get a certificate that includes the number of hours you did attend.
- Classes include hands-on activities. Participation in all activities will enhance your learning experience and allow you to get the most out of the class.

Online Training Registration Instructions

To register for classes online you must first log-in to the Care About Childcare website at <u>https://www.careaboutchildcare.utah.gov</u>. If you need assistance please call 801-326-4403

- Once you are logged-in, choose the Training Calendar link from the menu on the left side of the screen. Each class you see with a shopping cart next to it is available for online registration. Clicking on that cart adds that class to your list. When you are done adding the classes you wish to register for, you must click on the cart in the green box on the top right of the screen. Choose complete registration and follow the instructions to checkout.
- Online registration can only be completed for one person at a time by each person logging-in with their own username and password.
- Be sure to view and/or print your class schedule. **Please Note:** Online registrations will not receive a confirmation in the mail. Schedules can be viewed by clicking on My Class Registration on the menu to the left of the screen.
- Be sure to print your receipt. It is your only option to get a receipt.
- Once logged in you can also view other things such as your transcript of previous classes taken, your
 progress on the Career Ladder and your Annual Award eligibility date. This is also where family
 providers and center directors can view and update their CAC Marketing Page and view and submit
 verification for quality criteria.

PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT Care About Childcare

- Punctuality / Attendance: I understand that I must be in class at or before the time scheduled for class to begin in order to obtain credit for the class. If I arrive after the time that class is scheduled to begin, I can use the time that I was actually in attendance for licensing credit, but I will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session to get Career Ladder credit for the course. This includes returning on time from breaks and lunch. Class will begin when the trainer determines that it is time to start. I understand that if I am not present during the entire class period, I will not receive Career Ladder credit for the session, and will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session in order to receive credit for the course.
- Disruptive Behavior: I will be respectful to all personnel that support the Professional Development System (i.e.: Care About Childcare, CCPDI staff, OCC staff, etc.). I will not use obscene, profane, threatening, discriminatory, harassing or abusive language. During class, I will be respectful to the trainer and others in attendance during each class session. I will not engage in any conversation or behavior that is disruptive or disrespectful to the trainer or other participants in the class. I will attentively participate in class. I will not text message or make cell phone calls during class time. I understand that I am required to turn my cell phone and/or other electronic devices off or turn them to vibrate during class time. I will limit all cell phone calls to break time or after class time. I will not engage in disruptive private conversations during class time. If I must bring food or drink to class, I will eat quietly and will not allow food or drink to become disruptive or distracting to the trainer or other class participants.
- Illegal Activity I Health & Safety: I understand that any illegal activity, including behavior that threatens the health or safety of the trainer or another class participant before, during or after class will be cause for my immediate expulsion from class and permanent suspension from participation in the Career Ladder and the Professional Development Award, and that such behavior may be reported to law enforcement. The Orientation covers an overview of the process, the eligibility and training hour requirements, what classes to register for next, how the classes you take fit into the Career Ladder system, etc. Also, at the Orientation, you will be able to create an individual plan for the next CDA Support Workshops to attend as well.

Support Workshops cover various topics including:

- The 6 Competency Standards and 13 Functional Areas as defined by the CDA Council
- The philosophy of Developmentally Appropriate Practice and how it relates to the CDA
- Organization and components of the Professional Portfolio
- Family Questionnaires
- Verification Visit, including the Observation, Reflective Dialogue, and CDA Exam
- Renewal Procedures

As part of the process, everyone interested in a CDA is required to obtain 120 hours of formal early childhood training. In addition to registering for an upcoming CDA Orientation, you can also begin to register for, and attend, classes listed as Levels 1-3, which will put you on track to have almost all of the 120 hours completed!

Top Star Success Story

This newsletter, we are highlighting Ilse Wilson of Fairyland Family Child Care to recognize her excellence in providing children with environments conducive to healthy eating and physical activity. Top Star (Targeting Obesity in Preschools and Childcare Settings) representatives from the Utah Department of Health and the Salt Lake County Health Department had the privilege of visiting Ilse's family care site in July and were dazzled by her facility and the strides she has made to ensure the children in her care make healthy choices.

Ilse's home is a child's paradise. Her operation is located primarily in the basement of her house, and entering her domain, you can see that Ilse is highly organized and talented at what she does. Ilise is unique in that she is both Top Star (a state program) and Let's Move! Child Care (a national program) endorsed, and her commitment to these programs shows. In the eating area adjacent to the main playroom, children sit peacefully around a table drinking low-fat milk and serving themselves peaches, carrots, and whole-grain crackers using child-sized servings bowls, utensils, and pitchers. Ilse notes that serving food family-style (where children serve themselves from communal bowls, which is encouraged in the Top Star program) was intimidating to her at first, but is a simple and doable change (as long as plenty of washcloths are around for spills!). Other nutrition changes Ilse has made over the years include celebrating holidays with non-food items rather than cupcakes or candy, constructing a healthy, seasonally-based rotating menu, and involving children in the cultivating and harvest of the fresh produce in her garden.

Ilse's backyard is where the majority of physical activity takes place. Ilse demonstrates that childcare providers need not have huge backyards or unlimited resources to encourage physical activity, and there is a creative, budget-friendly, and "do-it-yourself" spirit here. For example, Ilse has set up various 'stations' around her backyard, including a Mud, Sand, and Water Play station, a Music station (complete with a xylophone made from PVC pipe), and so forth. She also created a homemade water fountain to provide children with unlimited access to drinking water. On cold or poor air quality days, Ilse gets creative and moves the children inside to play parachute games and an "ABC Exercise Game."

The benefits from becoming Top Star endorsed are not limited to improving the children's health, Ilse reports. She says that since becoming involved in Top Star and Let's Move! Child Care, the children's behavior has improved, and business has boomed: she has a full daycare and 80 children on her wait-list. Additionally, these endorsements provide legitimacy to her program, and parents are respectful as a result—she never has late pick-ups or late payments. Ilse is a pillar in Utah's childcare community and indicates that she is happy to share resources and experiences with other childcare providers looking to make healthy changes in their facilities.

Free Divorce Education for Children from Utah State Courts

When adults go through a divorce, there are programs available to assist them in making the transition, including a class offered through the Utah State Courts. But what about the children of divorcing parents? Nearly 12,000 Utah children are impacted by divorce each year, including more than 5,000 children in Salt Lake County. A gap exists between programs that are available for adults and classes available for children of divorcing parents. Because of this gap children are often left confused and full of mixed emotions when going through the divorce process.

To fill this need, the Utah State Courts has developed a program called Divorce Education for Children. This class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program's curriculum provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Mental health professionals teach the class with assistance from state court judges and commissioners.

FREE Class Information:

The Divorce Education for Children class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program is taught by a mental health professional and provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Classes are offered in Logan, Ogden, Provo and Salt Lake City.
