Scholarships and Financial Support

• EARLY EDUCATION PAYBACK PROGRAM

Provides reimbursement for the cost of early childhood education college credits. Students can earn up to \$3,500 per semester while working at least 15 hours in the early childhood education field.

• CAREER LADDER APPROVED COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Earn up to \$750 per <u>Career Ladder-approved course</u> for up to 12 credit hours/semester as a reimbursement payment

• CONFERENCE REGISTRATION SCHOLARSHIP

Earn up to \$500 per year as a reimbursement payment for attending a conference in the early childhood field that meet the requirements of a <u>Professional Activity</u> on the Career Ladder.

• ONGOING OCC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Office of Child Care (OCC) and the Utah Registry or Professional Development (URPD) provide financial support for individuals working towards professional development goals in the youth and early childhood fields. This email will contain the course link, handouts, code of conduct, and other applicable course information. If you do not receive an email, please contact the training department by 4pm to receive that information.

CAC-CSS Class Cancelation Policy

- Care About Childcare (CAC) ~ Children's Service Society will only cancel a class due to extreme weather, disaster, low enrollment, or if an instructor has an emergency and no instructors are available to substitute.
- It is the responsibility of the class participant to call or text 801-707-0265 to inquire whether classes have been cancelled due to weather or disaster.
- Every attempt will be made by a CAC staff member to notify class participants by text, call, or e-mail that a class has been canceled due to low enrollment.
- The decision to cancel classes because of weather or disaster will be made before 4:00 pm on weekdays and 7:30 am on Saturdays.
- The decision to cancel classes because of low enrollment will be made at least 2 days prior to the first day of the course.
- Cancelled sessions will be re-scheduled ASAP, and the participants will be notified by text, call, or email when the class is rescheduled.

Child Care and Americans with Disabilities Act

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is a federal civil rights law that Congress passed in 1990. Among other things, the ADA prohibits discrimination by child care centers and family child care providers against individuals with disabilities. The ADA requires that child care providers not discriminate against persons with disabilities on the basis that they provide children and parents with disabilities with an equal opportunity to participate in the child care programs and services. The ADA requires that child care providers provide an equal opportunity for each child to participate in the child care program and services. For further information and details visit ada.gov. 

T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® UTAH SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDCARE PROFESSIONALS WHO DESIRE AN ASSOCIATE OR BACHELOR DEGREE IN EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT

What is T.E.A.C.H.?

The T.E.A.C.H. Program:

- Links education, compensation, and commitment to improving the quality of early childcare.
- Provides scholarships for early childhood professionals to earn an AS or BS degree in Early Childhood Education.
- Is a partnership for the sharing of expenses between the recipient, their sponsoring program and T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® UTAH.

Who is Eligible for a T.E.A.C.H. scholarship?

- Any Childcare professional may be eligible if the applicant:
- Is a Utah resident.
- Has a high school diploma or a GED from an accredited school.
- Works a minimum of 20 hours per week.
- Has the support and sponsorship of the program where they are employed.
- Has the desire to earn a degree in Early Childhood Education.

What does the T.E.A.C.H. scholarship cover?

The scholarship provides:

Most of the cost of tuition and books, a per semester stipend for travel, paid released time support, compensation for contract completion, and counseling and administrative support.
