- Well-child exams
- Immunizations
- Doctor visits
- Hospital and emergency care
- Prescriptions
- Hearing and eye exams
- Mental Health Services
- Dental Care

WHO MAY BE ELIGIBLE?

- Non-U.S. citizen citizen who is not a lawfully permanent resident (LPR/Green Card holder)
- Living in Utah for 180 days or more
- Under age 19
- Not currently covered by health insurance
- Not eligible for Medicaid or CHIP
- Meet income requirements (before taxes)



All Medicaid cases will be reviewed

Take these steps to make sure you still have health insurance

- Make sure your information is up-to-date. Find out when your case will be reviewed at jobs.utah.gov/mycase
- Pay close attention to your myCase account, mail, and email. They will send you a letter and information
- Complete any paperwork or forms
- Send any supporting documents or paperwork they ask for
- Pay attention to deadlines so you don't lose your health insurance
