#### **CAC-CSS Class Cancelation Policy**

- Care About Childcare (CAC) ~ Children's Service Society will only cancel a class due to extreme weather, disaster, low enrollment, or if an instructor has an emergency and no instructors are available to substitute.
- It is the responsibility of the class participant to call or text 801-707-0265 to inquire whether classes have been cancelled due to weather or disaster.
- Every attempt will be made by a CAC staff member to notify class participants by text, call, or e-mail that a class has been canceled due to low enrollment.
- The decision to cancel classes because of weather or disaster will be made before 4:00 pm on weekdays and 7:30 am on Saturdays.
- The decision to cancel classes because of low enrollment will be made at 24 hours prior to the first day of the course.
- Cancelled sessions will be re-scheduled ASAP, and the participants will be notified by text, call, or email when the class is rescheduled.

Programs and Users should log into their CAC account.
Programs will go to "My Programs" and then to Course Cart.
Providers will go into "Professional Development and then into their course cart.

#### HOW TO USE YOUR VOUCHERS:

Programs and Users should log into their CAC account then click on "course cart".
Choose how many vouchers you will be using. Then click submit to finish checkout.



#### **CHECKOUT:**

Programs can pay for staff with vouchers.
Staff select "program pay" at checkout, and the program approves or denies.
To use vouchers, the program selects the amount and checks out.

#### What is T.E.A.C.H.?

#### The T.E.A.C.H. Program:

- Links education, compensation, and commitment to improving the quality of early childcare.
- Provides scholarships for early childhood professionals to earn an AS or BS degree in Early Childhood Education.
- Is a partnership for the sharing of expenses between the recipient, their sponsoring program and T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® UTAH.

#### Who is Eligible for a T.E.A.C.H. scholarship?

Any Childcare professional may be eligible if the applicant:

- Is a Utah resident.
- Has a high school diploma or a GED from an accredited school.
- Works a minimum of 20 hours per week.
- Has the support and sponsorship of the program where they are employed.
- Has the desire to earn a degree in Early Childhood Education.

#### What does the T.E.A.C.H. scholarship cover?

#### The scholarship provides:

Most of the cost of tuition and books, a per semester stipend for travel, paid released time support, compensation for contract completion, and counseling and administrative support.





## Child Care Quality System

#### What is the Child Care Quality System?

The Child Care Quality System (CCQS) is a certified rating system designed to identify the level of quality care a program implements to create positive outcomes for the children in Utah's communities. Additionally, it facilitates access for economically disadvantaged families to attend childcare establishments distinguished as 'High Quality' throughout the state.

Child care programs who complete the CCQS application will receive a certified quality rating. Such ratings signify adherence to established best practices, rigorously assessed and validated by the Department of Workforce Services Office of Child Care. The objective is to ensure that children in childcare environments experience positive developmental outcomes. Evaluation within this program encompasses assessment across five distinct domains on the CCQS framework, ensuring comprehensive program quality. The five domains include:

#### Domain 1: Health & Safety

- o Category 1: Licensing Compliance
- Category 2: Health & Safety Program Participation

#### <u>Domain 2: Learning Environments & Relationships</u>

- Category 1: Ratio's and Group Sizes
- Category 2: Observation
- Category 3: Family Engagement

#### <u>Domain 3: Leadership & Professional Development</u>

 Differs between Center-based programs & licensed Family programs

#### Domain 4: Management & Administration

• Professional Development of the administrator responsible for business operations

#### **Domain 5: National Accreditation**

• Obtain Accreditation from one of the approved Accreditation programs

#### **HOW DOES EHCC WORK?**

- Partners with child care professionals
- Identifies toxicants in child care facilities
- Works to prevent adverse health effects from exposures

#### WHAT ARE SOME WAYS CHILD CARE FACILITIES CAN BE MORE ECO-HEALTHY?

Avoid conditions that lead to excess moisture, Maintain adequate ventilation, Avoid manufactured air fresheners, Don't allow smoking on premises, and Avoid idling vehicles in parking areas.





#### WHY IS BEING ECO-HEALTHY IN CHILDCARE IMPORTANT?

Environmental hazards in child care facilities can adversely impact children's health. The health of humans, wildlife, and ecosystems are inherently interdependent. Children's environmental health focuses on protecting children's health from all environmental hazards, including climate change.

#### **GET ENDORSED**

Eco-Healthy Child Care® (EHCC) endorsed providers are taking a strong stand for children's health and well-being! Safeguarding our youngest from harmful environmental hazards is paramount. With children spending hours each day in child care, creating safer, healthier settings is vital.

#### Child Care and Americans with Disabilities Act

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is a federal civil rights low that Congress passed in 1990. Among other things, the ADA prohibits discrimination by child care centers and family child care providers against individuals with disabilities.

The ADA requires that child care providers not discriminate against persons with disabilities on the basis that they provide children and parents with disabilities with an equal apportunity to participate in the child care programs and services.

The ADA requires that child core providers provide on equal opportunity for each child to porticipate in the child core program and services.


