Attention all Caregivers!

With the Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) reauthorization there are new mandatory topics that need to be covered in pre-service training. This training must be completed by every person who provides care to children in a program that receives any money from the Office of Child Care (OCC); including subsidies, grants, and the Professional Development Award. Caregivers who work at licensed centers and homes, at any license-exempt program that receives money from OCC, including after school programs, Residential Certificate holders, and FFN Approved providers, need the pre-service training.

For new programs and caregivers, the pre-service training must be completed before they care for children. For current caregivers, the CCDF required pre-service training must be completed by August 31, 2016.

The mandatory preservice training will be available beginning March 1st from your local Care About Childcare, Child Care Licensing, and the Utah Afterschool Network. After completing the training, certificates will need to be submitted to Child Care Licensing or the Child Care Professional Development Institute (CCPDI).

Effective October 1, 2016, any program who has not submitted a pre-service training completed certificate for each caregiver will not receive any payments from OCC, including subsidies and grants.

All Care About Childcare programs are funded by the Federal Child Care and Development Fund, the Department of Workforce Services, and the Office of Child Care.

Pre-service Training must be completed by all caregivers before August 31st 2016!

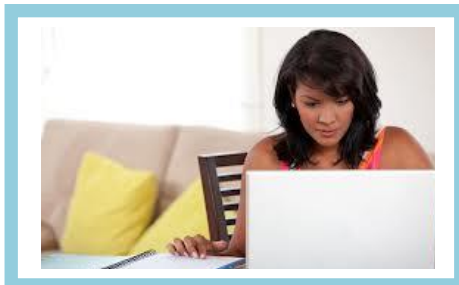

- Once you are logged-in, choose the Training Calendar link from the menu on the left side of the screen. Each class you see with a shopping cart next to it is available for online registration. Clicking on that cart adds that class to your list. When you are done adding the classes you wish to register for, you must click on the cart in the green box on the top right of the screen. Choose complete registration and follow the instructions to checkout.

PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

Care About Childcare

- **Punctuality / Attendance:** I understand that I must be in class at or before the time scheduled for class to begin in order to obtain credit for the class. If I arrive after the time that class is scheduled to begin, I can use the time that I was actually in attendance for licensing credit, but I will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session to get Career Ladder credit for the course. This includes returning on time from breaks and lunch. Class will begin when the trainer determines that it is time to start. I understand that if I am not present during the entire class period, I will not receive Career Ladder credit for the session, and will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session in order to receive credit for the course.
- **Disruptive Behavior:** I will be respectful to all personnel that support the Professional Development System (i.e.: Care About Childcare, CCPDI staff, OCC staff, etc.). I will not use obscene, profane, threatening, discriminatory, harassing or abusive language. During class, I will be respectful to the trainer and others in attendance during each class session. I will not engage in any conversation or behavior that is disruptive or disrespectful to the trainer or other participants in the class. I will attentively participate in class. I will not text message or make cell phone calls during class time. I understand that I am required to turn my cell phone and/or other electronic devices off or turn them to vibrate during class time. I will limit all cell phone calls to break time or after class time. I will not engage in disruptive private conversations during class time. If I must bring food or drink to class, I will eat quietly and will not allow food or drink to become disruptive or distracting to the trainer or other class participants.
- **Illegal Activity I Health & Safety:** I understand that any illegal activity, including behavior that threatens the health or safety of the trainer or another class participant before, during or after class will be cause for my immediate expulsion from class and permanent suspension from participation in the Career Ladder and the Professional Development Award, and that such behavior may be reported to law enforcement. I understand that I may be asked to leave a class if my condition prevents me from participating or is disruptive to the class environment.
- **Children:** I understand that adult training classes are not a developmentally appropriate environment for children of any age. I will not bring children to class.
- **Class Roll:** I understand that in order to receive credit for each class session, I must sign the roll before class begins. I understand that failure to do so will result in my not receiving credit for the class session. I understand that I may not sign the roll for someone else.
- **Confidentiality:** I understand that confidentiality is extremely important. I understand that I must keep all names and other identifying information confidential when I am relating a story during class or asking for guidance regarding certain issues. I also understand that it is my responsibility to keep sensitive issues discussed during class in confidence, and not discuss it with family or friends outside of that classroom setting.
- **Refunds:** I understand that class registration fees are non-refundable. I understand that if I notify Care About Childcare a minimum of two days in advance when I am unable to attend a course for which I am registered, that my registration fee may be able to be credited toward another class. I understand that it is my responsibility to contact the Care About Childcare to make these arrangements.
- **Non-Compliance:** I understand that, in cases of infractions of a minor severity (behavior that has been determined to be disruptive but not illegal), that I will be allowed one issued verbal warning upon the first violation of the above listed rules. There is a growing trend for child care providers to show demonstrated competency in the Early Childhood field, and a CDA is a great way to do it! Receiving this credential is not only one of the ways to achieve Level 4 on the Career Ladder, but it will also show your ability to put what you learn into action each day with the children in your care. The services we offer, and materials we provide, are FREE for providers in licensed programs and designed to assist you through each step of the process!

If you believe pursuing a CDA is right for you, or you are still deciding if it is, please register for an upcoming FREE CDA Orientation offered on the Class Schedule for this quarter. The Orientation covers an overview of the process, the eligibility and training hour requirements, what classes to register for next, how the classes you take fit into the Career Ladder system, etc. Also, at the Orientation, you will be able to create an individual plan for the next CDA Support Workshops to attend as well.

Milo's birth mother felt that caring for her child with severe medical issues was more than she was able to handle, and she chose to place him for adoption. The hospital social worker referred her to CSS because of our positive reputation in the community and our expertise in special needs adoptions. We located a family who had experience with Milo's diagnosis, and they were happy to adopt this beautiful child.

Children's Service Society's adoption program has completed more than 2,700 adoptions since 1930. We take great pride in the ethical nature of our adoption services; and more than just following our state laws, we strive to meet high standards of social work practices. It is in part because of these values that CSS is the only private agency in the state of Utah contracted to write home studies for the Utah Division of Child and Family Services.

Connections

Our Connections program is invested in more than just helping CSS's former clients to reunite with biological families separated by adoption. Currently all adoption records in Utah are sealed whether a birthparent wants them to be or not, despite the majority of today's birthparents requesting an open adoption. The Connections program has worked very hard, though yet unsuccessfully, on a bill to allow adoptees access to their adoption records. CSS will continue to strive towards creating ethical adoption practices for all involved in the State of Utah.

- Post-adoption birth parent counseling
- Domestic infant and special needs adoptive placements
- Home studies for Utah DCFS adoptions

The Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the Strengthening Families Protective Factor Framework can help improve clarity and precision in your work with families.

The Bureau is offering to partner with interested childcare programs in the service of families; we provide access to training, materials, tools, and ongoing support in integrating the ASQ into your program. In addition to providing insight on how to work with a specific child in the moment, screening is the first step to identifying children who could benefit from additional services to improve their outcomes now and down the road.

We're also in the process of applying and adapting the Strengthening Families Protective Factors Framework to a variety of fields across the state. This strengths-based framework puts the work that we do with individual children every day in the larger context of the family, and what each partner, program, and provider contributes to that family's development of the five protective factors:

- Parental Resilience
- Social Connections
- Knowledge of parenting and child development
- Concrete support in times of need
- Social and emotional competence of children

Free Divorce Education for Children from Utah State Courts

When adults go through a divorce, there are programs available to assist them in making the transition, including a class offered through the Utah State Courts. But what about the children of divorcing parents? Nearly 12,000 Utah children are impacted by divorce each year, including more than 5,000 children in Salt Lake County. A gap exists between programs that are available for adults and classes available for children of divorcing parents. Because of this gap children are often left confused and full of mixed emotions when going through the divorce process.

To fill this need, the Utah State Courts has developed a program called Divorce Education for Children. This class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program's curriculum provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Mental health professionals teach the class with assistance from state court judges and commissioners.

FREE Class Information:

The Divorce Education for Children class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program is taught by a mental health professional and provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Classes are offered in Logan, Ogden, Provo and Salt Lake City.
