T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood is coming to Utah! UAEYC will be its home & it will launch Fall 2016!

The early childhood workforce is significant and matters to our nation. An estimated 2.3 million early educators work in early care and education settings with young children ages birth to twelve across the country. Early educators are largely female, ethnically diverse, earn low wages and receive few, if any, employee benefits. Despite the need for early educators to be educated, they lack the resources to attain college credentials and degrees they need to provide critical services for children and families.

Child Care Services Association (CCSA) recognized many years ago that in order to provide quality early care and education services, the education, compensation and retention of the early childhood workforce would need to be addressed. With a bold mission to create a sustainable strategy to improve the education level of those working with young children in out-of-home settings, CCSA implemented the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® (Teacher Education and Compensation Helps or T.E.A.C.H.) Project in 1990.

T.E.A.C.H. is a cost-sharing model that spreads the cost of higher education among the recipient, the employer and T.E.A.C.H. – providing early educators with funding needed to earn credentials and degrees at community colleges and universities, as well as paid release time and a bonus or a raise. Licensed organizations in states across the country implement the model to fidelity with the support of shared tools, technical assistance and training provided by the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® National Center.

In its first year, T.E.A.C.H. served 21 early educators in North Carolina. Today, an average of 20,000 recipients are served annually in over 500 colleges and universities in 23 states and the District of Columbia. Nationally, over 120,000 recipients have benefitted from public-private partnerships between and among preschool, higher education and workforce development.

T.E.A.C.H. is a model that has created real change for real people working on the front lines of a critically important, but perpetually under-resourced industry. Over twenty years of steady, effective incremental growth have created an award-wining model and transformative results -- for the individual recipient, their families, their employers, the children in their care, the institutions of higher education where they learn, and the communities where they work and live -semester after semester.

Five Components of T.E.A.C.H.

Utilizing private-public partnerships, T.E.A.C.H. employs a multi-pronged, comprehensive strategy to educate and retain early childhood teachers, positively impacting outcomes for the children in their care. T.E.A.C.H. is comprised of five components:

- **1. Comprehensive Scholarships** Provide support for early educators to access college courses, certificates and degrees in child development or early childhood education resulting in no student debt.
- **2.** College Education Require completion of a specified number of credit hours per contract at a participating college or university coupled with support from T.E.A.C.H. counselors.
- **3.** Counselor Support each recipient by providing a state-based T.E.A.C.H. Counselor able to assist the student in securing a scholarship, navigating the college processes, helping the student balance work, family and school and monitoring progress and needs.
- **4.** Compensation Increase earnings through the provision of a bonus and/or a raise for recipients who complete their education in a prescribed period of time to support economic viability of staff.
- **5.** Commitment Establish a contract between employee, employer and T.E.A.C.H. that requires the recipient to remain in the sponsoring program for a specified period of time (generally a year) after they receive their degree to reduce staff turnover.

Online Training Registration Instructions

To register for classes online you must first log-in to the Care About Childcare website at <u>https://www.careaboutchildcare.utah.gov</u>. If you need assistance please call 801-326-4403

- Once you are logged-in, choose the Training Calendar link from the menu on the left side of the screen. Each class you see with a shopping cart next to it is available for online registration. Clicking on that cart adds that class to your list. When you are done adding the classes you wish to register for, you must click on the cart in the green box on the top right of the screen. Choose complete registration and follow the instructions to checkout.
- Online registration can only be completed for one person at a time by each person logging-in with their own username and password.
- Be sure to view and/or print your class schedule. Please Note: Online registrations will not receive a confirmation in the mail. Schedules can be viewed by clicking on My Class Registration on the menu to the left of the screen.
- Be sure to print your receipt. It is your only option to get a receipt.
- Once logged in you can also view other things such as your transcript of previous classes taken, your
 progress on the Career Ladder and your Annual Award eligibility date. This is also where family
 providers and center directors can view and update their CAC Marketing Page and view and submit
 verification for quality criteria.

PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT Care About Childcare

- **Punctuality I Attendance:** I understand that I must be in class at or before the time scheduled for class to begin in order to obtain credit for the class. If I arrive after the time that class is scheduled to begin, I can use the time that I was actually in attendance for licensing credit, but I will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session to get Career Ladder credit for the course. This includes returning on time from breaks and lunch. Class will begin when the trainer determines that it is time to start. I understand that if I am not present during the entire class period, I will not receive Career Ladder credit for the session, and will have to repeat the full 2 1/2 hour session in order to receive credit for the course.
- Disruptive Behavior: I will be respectful to all personnel that support the Professional Development System (i.e.: Care About Childcare, CCPDI staff, OCC staff, etc.). I will not use obscene, profane, threatening, discriminatory, harassing or abusive language. During class, I will be respectful to the trainer and others in attendance during each class session. I will not engage in any conversation or behavior that is disruptive or disrespectful to the trainer or other participants in the class. I will attentively participate in class. I will not text message or make cell phone calls during class time. I understand that I am required to turn my cell phone and/or other electronic devices off or turn them to vibrate during class time. I will limit all cell phone calls to break time or after class time. I will not engage in disruptive private conversations during class time. If I must bring food or drink to class, I will eat quietly and will not allow food or drink to become disruptive or distracting to the trainer or other class participants.
- Illegal Activity I Health & Safety: I understand that any illegal activity, including behavior that threatens the health or safety of the trainer or another class participant before, during or after class will be cause for my immediate expulsion from class and permanent suspension from participation in the Career Ladder and the Professional Development Award, and that such behavior may be reported to law enforcement. I understand that I may be asked to leave a class if my condition prevents me from participating or is disruptive to the class environment.
- **Children:** I understand that adult training classes are not a developmentally appropriate environment for children of any age. I will not bring children to class.
- **Class Roll:** I understand that in order to receive credit for each class session, I must sign the roll before class begins. I understand that failure to do so will result in my not receiving credit for the class session. I understand that I may not sign the roll for someone else.
- **Confidentiality:** I understand that confidentiality is extremely important. I understand that I must keep all names and other identifying information confidential when I am relating a story during class or asking for guidance regarding certain issues. I also understand that it is my responsibility to keep sensitive issues discussed during class in confidence, and not discuss it with family or friends outside of that classroom setting.
- **Refunds:** I understand that class registration fees are non-refundable. I understand that if I notify Care About Childcare a minimum of two days in advance when I am unable to attend a course for which I am registered, that my registration fee may be able to be credited toward another class. I understand that it is my responsibility to contact the Care About Childcare to make these arrangements.
- Non-Compliance: I understand that, in cases of infractions of a minor severity (behavior that has been determined to be disruptive but not illegal), that I will be allowed one issued verbal warning upon the first violation of the above listed rules. I understand that upon the second such infraction, I will be suspended from participation in the Career Ladder and Professional Development Award System for one year from that infraction date. Puntualidad/ Asistencia: Entiendo que debo estar presente en la clase a la hora o, antes de la hora establecida para el comienzo de la misma para obtener crédito por la totalidad de la clase. Si llego después de la hora de comienzo establecida, puedo utilizar el tiempo real presente en la clase para obtener crédito para el mantenimiento de mi licencia, pero tendré que repetir las 2 horas y media de la sesión para obtener crédito para el curso de Career Ladder. The services we offer, and materials we provide, are FREE for providers in licensed programs and designed to assist you through each step of the process!

If you believe pursuing a CDA is right for you, or you are still deciding if it is, please register for an upcoming FREE CDA Orientation offered on the Class Schedule for this quarter. The Orientation covers an overview of the process, the eligibility and training hour requirements, what classes to register for next, how the classes you take fit into the Career Ladder system, etc. Also, at the Orientation, you will be able to create an individual plan for the next CDA Support Workshops to attend as well.

Support Workshops cover various topics including:

- The NAEYC Code of Ethical Conduct
- The 6 Competency Standards and 13 Functional Areas as defined by the CDA Council
- The philosophy of Developmentally Appropriate Practice and how it relates to the CDA

- Renewal Procedures

As part of the process, everyone interested in a CDA is required to obtain 120 hours of formal early childhood training. Milo's birth mother felt that caring for her child with severe medical issues was more than she was able to handle, and she chose to place him for adoption. The hospital social worker referred her to CSS because of our positive reputation in the community and our expertise in special needs adoptions. We located a family who had experience with Milo's diagnosis, and they were happy to adopt this beautiful child.

Children's Service Society's adoption program has completed more than 2,700 adoptions since 1930. We take great pride in the ethical nature of our adoption services; and more than just following our state laws, we strive to meet high standards of social work practices. It is in part because of these values that CSS is the only private agency in the state of Utah contracted to write home studies for the Utah Division of Child and Family Services.

Connections

Our Connections program is invested in more than just helping CSS's former clients to reunite with biological families separated by adoption. Currently all adoption records in Utah are sealed whether a birthparent wants them to be or not, despite the majority of today's birthparents requesting an open adoption. The Connections program has worked very hard, though yet unsuccessfully, on a bill to allow adoptees access to their adoption records. CSS will continue to strive towards creating ethical adoption practices for all involved in the State of Utah.

- Home studies for Utah DCFS adoptions

Since its creation in 2002, the Connections program has helped to facilitate more than 100 adoption reunions.

Serving young children and their families is what childcare programs are all about. You do what you do because you care. At the Bureau of Child Development in the Utah Department of Health, we understand that, we honor that, and we want to help you do it. Our Early Childhood Utah program currently offers two game-changing tools to assist you in the good work you're already doing. The Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the Strengthening Families Protective Factor Framework can help improve clarity and precision in your work with families.

The Bureau is offering to partner with interested childcare programs in the service of families; we provide access to training, materials, tools, and ongoing support in integrating the ASQ into your program. In addition to providing insight on how to work with a specific child in the moment, screening is the first step to identifying children who could benefit from additional services to improve their outcomes now and down the road.

We're also in the process of applying and adapting the Strengthening Families Protective Factors Framework to a variety of fields across the state. This strengths-based framework puts the work that we do with individual children every day in the larger context of the family, and what each partner, program, and provider contributes to that family's development of the five protective factors:

- Parental Resilience
- Social Connections
- Knowledge of parenting and child development
- Concrete support in times of need
- Social and emotional competence of children

Free Divorce Education for Children from Utah State Courts

When adults go through a divorce, there are programs available to assist them in making the transition, including a class offered through the Utah State Courts. But what about the children of divorcing parents? Nearly 12,000 Utah children are impacted by divorce each year, including more than 5,000 children in Salt Lake County. A gap exists between programs that are available for adults and classes available for children of divorcing parents. Because of this gap children are often left confused and full of mixed emotions when going through the divorce process.

To fill this need, the Utah State Courts has developed a program called Divorce Education for Children. This class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program's curriculum provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Mental health professionals teach the class with assistance from state court judges and commissioners.

FREE Class Information:

The Divorce Education for Children class is available for children ages 9 to 12 and offered free of charge. The program is taught by a mental health professional and provides children with skills they can use to better communicate their feelings to parents and is designed to minimize the adverse effects divorce has on children. Classes are offered in Logan, Ogden, Provo and Salt Lake City.
